## Item 6 – Devolution Update

### Summary of devolution EOI submissions:

- North Northants submitted an EOI jointly with West Northants with the preference of the 6. This was only signed by North and West.
- West Northants submitted an EOI jointly with North Northants with the preference of the 6. This was only signed by North and West.
- **Milton Keynes** submitted an EOI jointly with Bedford and Luton with the preference of the 4 (BLMK). This was only signed by MK, Luton and Bedford.
- Luton submitted an EOI jointly with Bedford and MK with the preference of the 4 (BLMK).. This was only signed by MK, Luton and Bedford.
- **Bedford Borough** submitted an EOI jointly with MK and Luton with the preference of the 4 (BLMK). This was only signed by MK, Luton and Bedford.
- **Central Beds** Wrote a letter to government expressing interest in more time to make a decision and explore options with partners.

At the 18 February 2025 South Midlands Authorities Board meeting, a consensus was not made on devolution pathway regarding going in as a 4 or 6 region.

- Request the Local Authorities produce evidence of the pro and cons of 4 and 6 economic models, compare with previous CCOG economic model for central area proposal (2017).
